BEL boxer winner in Sully's private fight

BEL Boxing Club's Lita Mae Button was invited to a private boxing match put on by Sully's Gym of Toronto Thursday.

The bouts took place at the Downtown Toronto Sheraton's Cambridge Club, and featured nine bouts with boxers attending from across Ontario.

Button met Robyn Richards of St. Catharines in the 155 lb (light heavyweight) division in the fifth

bout and recorded a unanimous decision against her opponent.

"(Button) executed her game plan well," said coach Scott Eccles, "with straight focused punching to outscore Richards in all three rounds."

Next action for the Bridgenorth boxer is in Longueuil, Que. March 24-26, as she prepares for the Canadian Final Team Selection.
